

Sin and the Free Gift!

Sin—things that we think, do, and say that are contrary to God’s perfect standards. We all sin whether you are willing to admit it or not.

Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned. (Romans 5:12)¹

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23)

Sin Has Consequences!

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

“For as in Adam all die.” (1 Corinthians 15:22a)

And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this *comes* judgment. (Hebrews 9:27)

“In Christ all will be made alive.” (1 Corinthians 15:22b)
