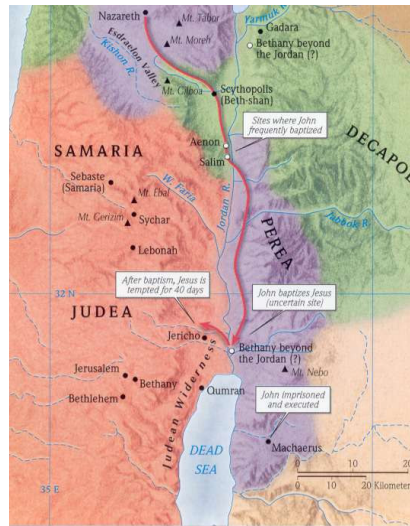
It is important to ensure fellowship with God before the study of the Word.

κατασκευάζω - "To make ready" the road that Messiah would walk - - was what John was designed for!



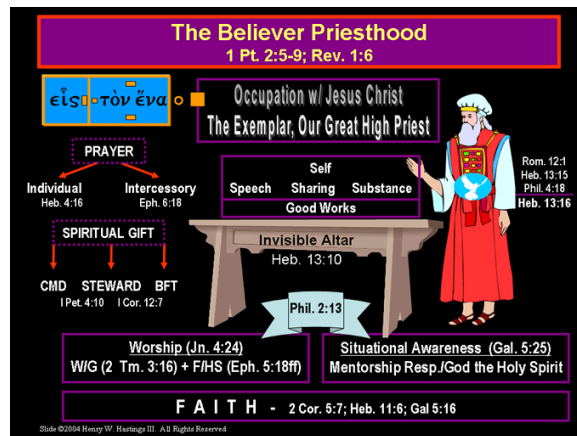
Satan's desire was to get Jesus Christ to function independently of the Father's will for Him.

Apart from the divine power!

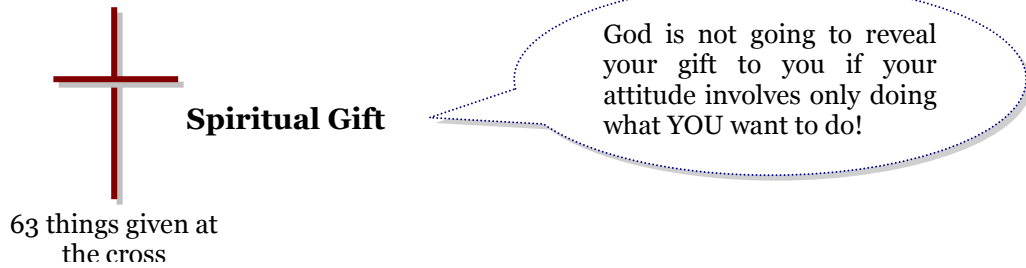
Identifying your spiritual gift is a prerequisite to fulfilling God's plan in its entirety.
