It is important to ensure fellowship with God before the study of the Word.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).

Hebrews 4:12 For the Word of God is alive and powerful, sharper than any two-edged sword.

The function of your spiritual gift is a cooperative work with God.

Philippians 2:13 For it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.

- Where do desires come from?
- The Old Sin Nature has its own desires. How do we determine just where our desires come from?

The Holy Spirit never acts contrary to the Word of God.

POD: The Spirit does not place desires upon our hearts that are contrary to the Word of God; however, the flesh will.

- The Word of God provides discernment.
- Willingness comes from within. **Romans 6:16, 9:1**

Galatians 4:6 Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of **His Son** into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

Romans 8:15-16 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which **we cry out**, "Abba! Father!" ¹⁶ The Spirit Himself testifies [bears witness] with our spirit that we are children of God.



1 John 4:4 “. . . greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world”.

1 Thessalonians 5:19 Do not quench the Spirit.

Galatians 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

Are all your activities in life supported by prayer?
